### Termination of agreement between COMCARE and the Urban League of Kansas.

Recommended Action: Approve the termination of this agreement and authorize the Chairman to sign termination letter.

Background: COMCARE has contracted with the Urban League of Kansas for several years to assist in delivering psychosocial rehabilitation and attendant care services for some of their Children's program clients. Under the terms of the agreement, either party may terminate the contract with thirty days written notice to the other. While it has been a beneficial partnership, COMCARE has made the financial decision to bring these services in-house and end the contract with Urban League effective August 31, 2013.

Alternatives: Should this termination not be approved, the current contract will remain in place until December 31, 2013.

Financial Considerations: This contract was supported by Medicaid Pass-Through funds, so no financial impact is expected.

Legal Considerations: This agreement was entered into under K.S.A. 19-101 and provided for termination by either party with thirty days written notice.

Policy Considerations: All Sedgwick County policies were followed in the termination process.
