A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION
OF THE 2016 FIRE DISTRICT 1 BUDGET

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 79-2925 et seq. requires the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, sitting as the governing body of Sedgwick County Fire District 1, to adopt an annual budget of all anticipated revenues and expenses, and, as adopted, such budget shall constitute an appropriation and authorization of the amount to be raised by taxation for the public purposes of the Sedgwick County Fire District 1; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, has by Resolution 347-1989, established a policy and procedure for the development of a Capital Improvement Program (CIP) to authorize, plan for, and carry out capital improvements and capital expenses and has determined that those capital improvement projects contained within the CIP should be designated as a part of the annual budget process; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of Fire District 1 has fully complied with all requirements of the applicable Kansas statute with respect to the review, official publication, and the holding of public hearings related to the adoption of the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Sedgwick County Commissioners, sitting as the governing body of Sedgwick County Fire District 1, that:

1. The budget of the Fire District 1 for the fiscal year of 2016 is hereby adopted in the form and in the amounts shown for the expenditures and taxes to be levied for the various funds in the attached CERTIFICATE (Attachment 1).


