RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPEED ZONE ON TYLER ROAD (87TH STREET WEST) BETWEEN THE NORTH CITY LIMITS OF MAIZE AND THE SOUTH LIMITS OF MAIZE BETWEEN 37TH STREET NORTH AND 45TH STREET NORTH (809-K mid 0.6 mile) IN SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2001 et. seq., has the power and authority with respect to streets and highways under their jurisdiction and within the reasonable exercise of the police power to enact and enforce resolutions regulating traffic, said resolutions relating to those subjects enumerated in L. 1996, ch. 15; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1560, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, is authorized to determine that any maximum speed permitted is greater or less than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon a highway or part of a highway and to determine and declare a reasonable and safe maximum limit thereon, subject to the provision therein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1560, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, determines that the maximum speed permitted is greater or less than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon Tyler Road (87th Street West) between the north city limits of Maize and the south city limits of Maize between 37th Street North and 45th Street North (809-K mid 0.6 mile), and further determines and declares a reasonable and safe maximum safe speed limit thereon to be 45 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

SECTION ONE: The reasonable and safe maximum safe speed limit of 45 miles per hour is established on Tyler Road (87th Street West) between the north city limits of Maize and the south city limits of Maize between 37th Street North and 45th Street North (809-K mid 0.6 mile).

SECTION TWO: The maximum speed limit so established shall be effective at all times.

SECTION THREE: The County Engineer is hereby directed to erect upon or at the entrances to the highway or part of a highway affected hereby, official traffic control devices as may be most appropriate, giving notice of the maximum speed limit, denoted in miles per hour, and hours of effectiveness, if necessary, established by this resolution; and that said traffic control devices be in conformity with the most recent edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

SECTION FOUR: All law enforcement officers with jurisdiction in Sedgwick County, Kansas, are hereby authorized to enforce the speed limit established in Section One hereof, and which has been properly signed as directed in Section Three hereof.

SECTION FIVE: Any person who shall violate any speed restriction established in this resolution shall be guilty of a misdemeanor as provided by law.
