The county continues to offer assistance to other entities struggling with potential contamination issues. Staff currently sits on a subdivision review committee to review proposed rural subdivisions and write requirements for onsite wastewater and water supply. Public works sits on the committee as well and address storm water runoff. Staff in Code Enforcement also reviews floodplain concerns for each proposal. Staff is involved in a WRAPS committee for the Lower Ark Basin Wraps.
