

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING GILBERT ALVAREZ TO THE  
SEDGWICK COUNTY JUVENILE CORRECTIONS ADVISORY BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, adopted Resolution No. 7-1999 establishing the Sedgwick County Juvenile Corrections Advisory Board pursuant to K.S.A. 75-7038 *et seq.*, as amended;

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2004, with Resolution 164-2004, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, amended Section 2(B)(8) of Resolution No. 7-1999 to increase the number of positions appointed by the Board of County Commissioners from three (3) to six (6);

WHEREAS, an unexpired term for an education position exists on the Juvenile Corrections Board due to resignation of Bill Faflick on June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to appoint Gilbert Alvarez to fill the unexpired term as an education member to the Sedgwick County Juvenile Corrections Advisory Board.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:**

Gilbert Alvarez is hereby appointed to serve as an education member on the Sedgwick County Juvenile Corrections Advisory Board. The term of appointment shall expire June 30, 2018, or until a successor has been appointed.


