

RESOLUTION ____ - 2013

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING THE SEDGWICK COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY CENTER FROM THE PROHIBITION IN K.S.A. 41-719(c) AGAINST CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Sedgwick County, Kansas owns real property, commonly known as the Sedgwick County Public Safety Center and located at 714 N. Main St., Wichita, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the County now desires to allow the use of alcoholic beverages for a special event to be held on the premises of said facility on April 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS, in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 41-719 the Kansas Legislature has provided for a general prohibition against the consumption of alcoholic liquor on public property, but also granted the board of county commissioners of any county the authority by resolution to exempt county property from said prohibition pursuant to K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 41-719(e).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas that:

- I. The real property commonly known as the Sedgwick County Public Safety Center, with an address of 714 N. Main St., Wichita, Kansas, and with title vested in Sedgwick County, shall be exempt from the provisions of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 41-719, and amendments thereto, prohibiting the consumption of alcoholic liquors on public property for the date of April 25, 2013.
- II. This resolution shall be effective upon passage by the Board of County Commissioners.
