**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING VIRGIL MILLER TO THE  
SEDGWICK COUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL ON AGING**

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 2-161 of the *Sedgwick County Code* provides for the establishment of the Sedgwick County Advisory Council on Aging, and Sec. 2-162 thereof provides for the appointment by the Board of County Commissioners of members thereto and their term of membership;

**WHEREAS**, a vacancy has been created due to the resignation of Jaime Brown, who was appointed by Commissioner Michael O'Donnell; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of Commissioner Michael O'Donnell that Virgil Miller be appointed to the Sedgwick County Advisory Council on Aging to fill the unexpired term of Jaime Brown.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that**

Virgil Miller is hereby appointed to the Sedgwick County Advisory Council on Aging. The term of this appointment shall expire on April 11, 2021, except that in the event the Commissioner making the recommendation for the appointment herein leaves office for any reason, the said term shall expire and the member shall then serve until a successor has been duly appointed.


