On the recommendation of Joe Thomas, on behalf of Risk Management, Tim Kaufman moved to **accept the proposal from Worksafe Physical Therapy, Inc. at the rates above and establish contract pricing for three (3) years with two (2) one-year options to renew.** Sara Jantz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

A committee comprised of Mick McBride and Tammy Brandt - Risk Management, Lindsey Mahoney - ADA Coordinator and Joe Thomas - Purchasing evaluated all of the proposals submitted for qualifications, methodology, and cost of services. Five (5) vendors were shortlisted, interviews conducted and references checked.

The committee chose Worksafe Physical Therapy, Inc. as having the best overall proposal.

Ergonomic assessments will represent the majority of the services required from the chosen vendor. Periodically, training sessions will be scheduled with groups of County personnel for cost savings. The methodology and cost per assessment provided by Worksafe Physical Therapy was considered the best among the group.

Question: How many assessments are conducted per year? Mick McBride responded there are, on average, 40-45 assessments, annually.

On the recommendation of Brandy McCune, on behalf of Fleet Management, Sara Jantz moved to **accept the low bid from Briggs Chrysler for the amount of \$79,689.00**. Tim Kaufman seconded the motion. The motion passed 3 to 1, with Linda Kizzire voting no.

These are replacement vehicles for the Sheriff's Office. The Ford Crown Victoria was the County's standard patrol vehicle and is no longer available; therefore, the Sheriff 's Office is going to test each make and model (Ford, Chevrolet, Dodge) of patrol vehicles offered to determine what the new County standard will be in the future. Surplus will be sold on Purple Wave.

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Comments:

Linda Kizzire stated, "For the price difference of \$1,181.13 between Davis Moore and Briggs, and the fact that Davis Moore, on that dealership alone, pays over \$128,000 in taxes, I feel that we should purchase from Davis Moore Automotive since they are a local vendor."

Sara Jantz stated, "Just to make sure we have it in the record, I understand that the policy is that we don't have a stipulation that within a certain range we can buy from a local vendor; it is just the lowest reasonable bid, correct?"

Joe Thomas stated that Sedgwick County does not have a local preference policy. As part of our process, we utilize K.S.A. 75-3740a, a Kansas statute that allows us to consider another jurisdiction's procurement policy including any local preference, in the County's evaluation of responses received. For example, if an out-of-state vendor submits the lowest bid and it is determined they have a local preference policy, we can consider their policy when evaluating the response prior to award. The advantage would then be applied to domiciled (Kansas) vendor. Since both of the vendors mentioned in this bid (Briggs Chrysler -- Lawrence, KS and Davis-Moore -- Wichita, KS) are domiciled vendors, this would not apply.

On the recommendation of Brandy McCune, on behalf of Fleet Management, Linda Kizzire moved to **accept the proposal for Murphy Tractor & Equipment Co. in the amount of \$466,566.00.** David Spears seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Rex Victory -Fleet Management, and Brandy McCune-Purchasing reviewed each proposal. Staff from Public Works, Fleet Management, and Purchasing attended demonstrations of each machine proposed, except for the Volvo EW210D; GW Van Keppel did not have a machine available to demo. The machines were evaluated based on initial purchase price, ease of operation, technical rating, maintenance cost, safety features, and warranty. All were in agreement that the John Deere 220D-W best meets the needs of the County.

These machines are used by Public Works on a daily basis for cleaning and removing debris from ditches, bridges, and streams that cause drainage problems. They are also used to load dirt or debris into trucks for removal. The clam shell bucket allows for removal of fence posts, sign posts, and tree stumps. The wheeled excavator can be driven to the work site instead of being hauled like the tracked excavator. A future use of these machines will be assisting in repairing old wooden bridges throughout the County that are being replaced with concrete boxes. These machines will aid in lifting and installing of the concrete boxes.

The machine that Murphy Tractor and GW Van Keppel bid as alternates are smaller machines and do not meet specifications. The Hyundai 210W-9 did not meet specifications on the bucket. During the demo the of the Hyundai machine, it was low on power and could not swing uphill with the loaded bucket, which is a common use when cleaning out ditches. Also, both cylinders were leaking oil on the machine; the machine had very few hours on it to have this type of problem.

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On the Doosan DX 210W the forward/reverse lever is on the column instead of on the floor or a joystick. Having the forward/reverse control lever on the column could be unsafe in some work procedures, like setting culverts such as lock joint (concrete). During this procedure, a concrete piece is hanging in the air while other coworkers are helping hold onto the piece as it is moved into place. The operator needs to move excavator forward or backwards and as this happens, the operator would have to remove his hand from the joystick to the control lever. By doing that, the operator could bump the hand lever and inadvertently drop the load or move the load, causing damage to culvert, machine or accidental injury to coworkers. Having the forward/reverse controller on the joystick or a foot pedal allows the operator to control the load and move the machine without removing their hand from the joystick at any time to complete the job. The operators also stated that visibility was poor out of the right side of the machine; it is important to be able to see any oncoming traffic while working on County roads. The machine is constantly swinging from the ditch to the truck, and the operator must be able to see both sides of the machine. The John Deere 220D-W had plenty of power with a loaded bucket, forward/reverse controller is located on the joystick, and it had good visibility around the whole machine. John Deere has moved the boom back behind the operator station to increase visibility out of all windows. Machine had easy access to component areas and also had non-slip material on steps and working areas for safety, as well as good fuel economy.

These are replacements for the East Yard and Clonmel Yard. The machines being replaced are 1998 Caterpillars; the life expectancy for the machines is 12-15 years. Surplus will be sold on Purple Wave.

PTT Interface to work with new radio system	<b>\$105,000.14</b>

On the recommendation of Kimberly Evans, on behalf of Emergency Communications, Tim Kaufman moved to **accept the quote from Northrop Grumman in the amount of \$105,000.14**. Sara Jantz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

As 911 migrates from an analog to a digital radio system, the Push to Talk (PTT) interface must be modified to function with the new P25 system. The PTT interface, a major field unit safety feature, not only displays to the dispatcher which field unit is talking, but also permits the person in the field to push their emergency button, on their mobile or portable radio, to alert 911 dispatchers the field unit is potentially in danger.

The existing analog system has this same interface. 911 is not adding anymore functionality but having the interface re-written to work on the new P-25 system.
