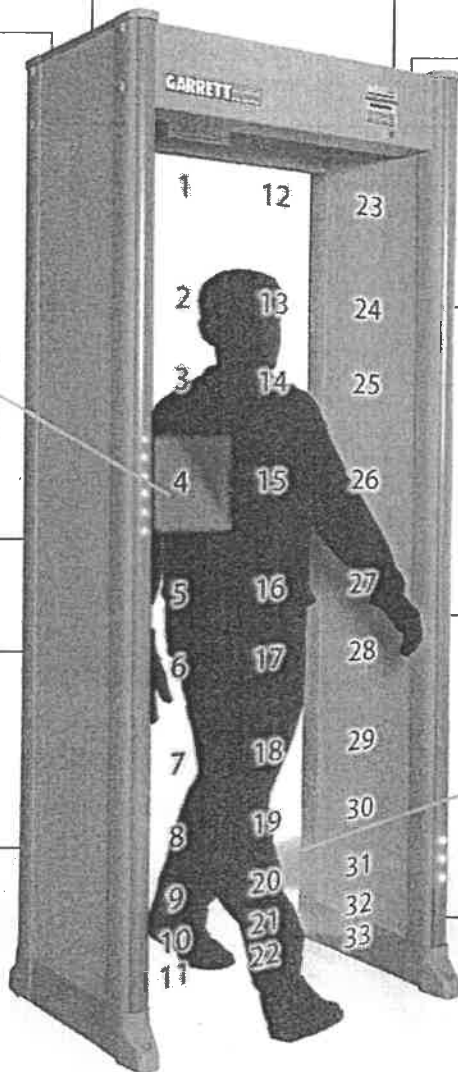

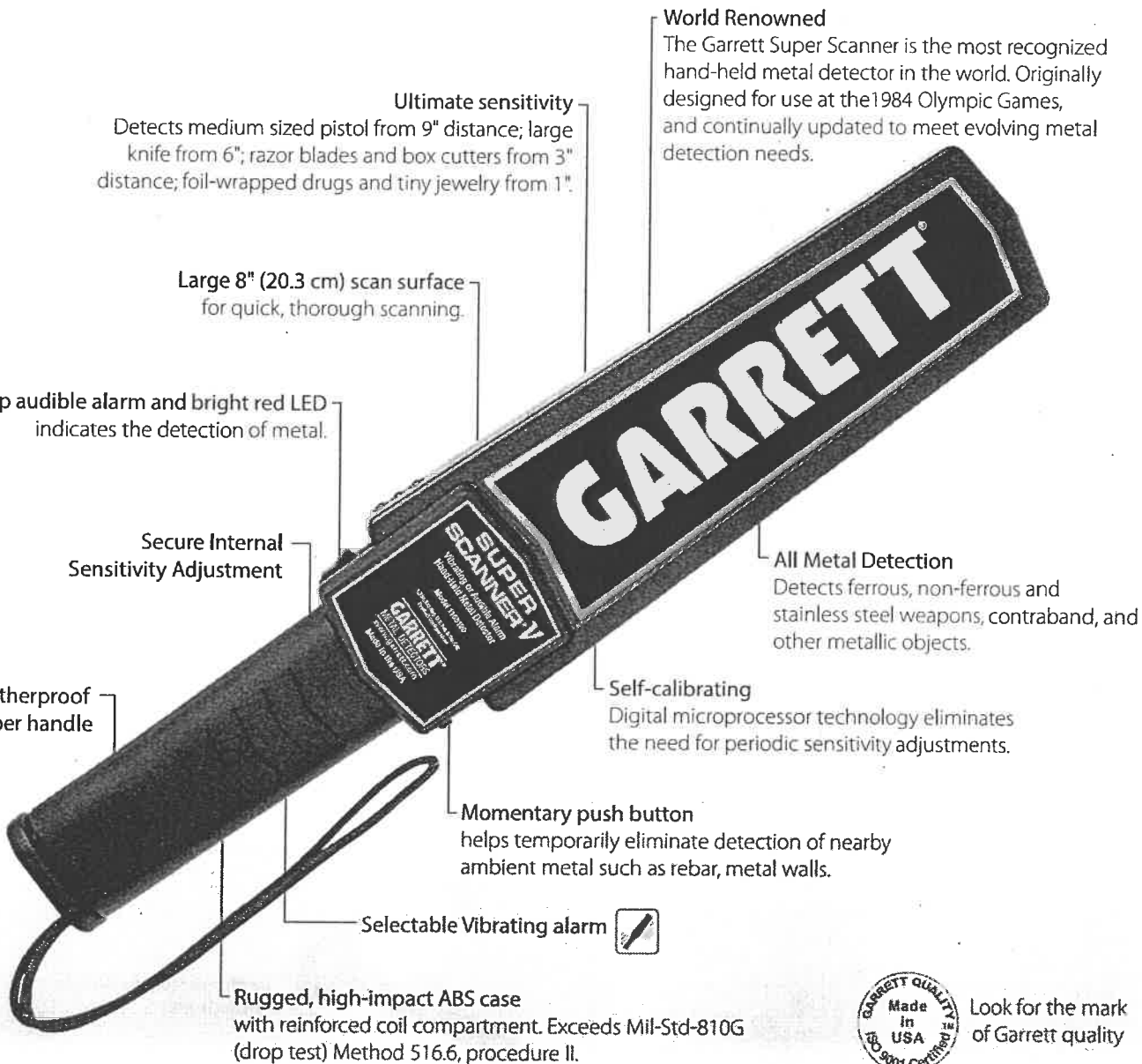

Project Description: (Below)

UFED files are a common type of evidence in criminal cases and file sizes can often exceed the capacity of a standard PC to open and navigate throughout the file. 'Universal Forensic Extraction Device' (UFED) is a forensic tool used with mobile phones, smartphones and computers. Data can be retrieved via logical extraction or via physical extraction (ie: hex dump). Extracted data includes basic handset data, the phonebook, SMS and MMS messages, SIM data, multimedia (e.g. images and videos stored on the phone), physical location and time and date stamps. The extracted data is deemed evidence and is provided by law enforcement as part of the case evidence. UFED files are critical evidence and the prosecutor must have the capability to open and review the file.
