On the recommendation of Kim Evans, on behalf of COMCARE and the Treasurer, Jennifer Dombaugh moved to **accept the low proposal from Securitas Security Services and establish contract pricing for three (3) years with two (2) one year options to renew.** Tim Kaufman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

A review committee comprised of Crystal Deselms, Hattie Buford and Nancy Patterson-Comcare, Martha Herridge-Tag Office and Kim Evans-Purchasing reviewed the responses.

The group unanimously agreed that Securitas met all proposal requirements and offered the best pricing.

Securitas Security Services is the current contracted provider for these services since 2008. In 2012, the Treasurer spent \$16,307.65 for its tag office locations and COMCARE spent \$460,225.00. Securitas Security Services proposed lower hourly rates than established on the previous contract.

Question was asked why there is such a large disparity between COMCARE annual spend and Tag Office annual spend. Linda Kizzire and Tim Kaufman commented that the Treasurer utilizes these services for far fewer hours per year and has far fewer facilities than COMCARE.

On the recommendation of Angee Sisco, on behalf of the Facilities Department, Linda Kizzire moved to **utilize State of Kansas Contracts 12741AA with Western Extralite Company, 12741AC with Consolidated Electrical Distributors, Inc. and 12741AD with Stanion Wholesale Electric Company, Inc. to expire January 31, 2014 with one (1) one-year option to renew.** Tim Kaufman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Under this contract Facilities Maintenance and other County staff will be able to purchase, and have delivered various electrical supplies including wire, boxes, switches, etc. Each item will receive a discount off list price based on manufacturer, product line, and vendor. A review committee consisting of Greg Tuxhorn and Pat Masterson, Facilities and Angee Sisco, Purchasing reviewed the contract and unanimously agreed on the recommendation. Purchasing has conducted market research, and found the State of Kansas prices to be competitive. Multiple vendors are recommended for award in order to mirror the State Contract, staff will choose vendor based on price, availability of items and delivery times.

* This item is not currently on contract, annual spend is unknown. Discounts may fluctuate based on manufacturer price fluctuations. The State of Kansas Contract Administrator is responsible for auditing to ensure continued competitive rates.
