**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AUTUMN BLACK TO
THE SEDGWICK COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH ADVISORY BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, has established, pursuant to K.S.A. 19-4002a and Sedgwick County Resolution No. 199-1986 (and amendments thereto), a Mental Health Advisory Board to make certain recommendations regarding mental health services and programs in Sedgwick County;

WHEREAS, Sec. 14-76 of the *Sedgwick County Code* provides for the appointment of members to the Sedgwick County Mental Health Advisory Board;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 14-76 of the *Sedgwick County Code*, in the event the Commissioner recommending the appointment of said member leaves office for any reason, said term shall expire;

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of Commissioner Richard Ranzau, Alta Sergovia, was appointed to said board for a term of four years;

WHEREAS, upon the departure of Commissioner Richard Ranzau from office, the regular term of Alta Sergovia has now expired, leaving a vacancy; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of Commissioner Lacey D. Cruse that Autumn Black be appointed to the Sedgwick County Mental Health Advisory Board for a term of four years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

Autumn Black is hereby appointed to the Sedgwick County Mental Health Advisory Board. The term of this appointment shall expire on March 19, 2023.
