

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL
PROPERTY TAX JUDGMENTS TO BE DORMANT

WHEREAS, certain personal property tax judgments arising on taxes assessed in the year 2009 remain uncollected after at least seven (7) years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized pursuant to K.S.A. 79-2017 to permit said judgments to become dormant judgments in the same manner as other judgments under K.S.A. 60-2403 and as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. After due consideration of all the facts and circumstances the Board finds that it is unreasonable to expect that any of the outstanding judgments obtained as a result of non-payment of the personal property taxes assessed for 2009, which include 1,076 accounts in the amount of \$465,877.61 (\$270,820.54 General Tax and \$195,057.07 Interest and Fees) which remain unpaid as of the date hereof will be collected in the future. Said judgments have remained uncollected for at least seven (7) years and that the same should be and they are hereby allowed to become dormant judgments as defined by K.S.A. 60-2403 and as amended.

SECTION II. The County Clerk shall deliver to the Clerk of the District Court of the Eighteenth Judicial District a certified copy of this resolution.


