RE: Juvenile Detention Facilities Fund Grant

Dear Mr. Masterson:

The Juvenile Justice Authority will be releasing the SFY 2013 Juvenile Detention Facilities Fund (JDFF) grants to twelve non-profit juvenile detention facilities operating in the State of Kansas according to the percentage of **licensed capacity** of each juvenile detention facility. Kansas law requires that the JDFF be spent only on the following categories:

- **construction**
- **renovation/remodeling**
- **personnel**
- **equipment/supplies**
- **other operational costs**

The amount awarded to your facility, based on the licensed capacity of your facility on March 22, 2002, will be **\$108,000**. When assembling your budget plan keep in mind that future allocations may decrease due to increased per diem costs, decrease revenues, or Legislative actions.

The deadline for submission is June 1, 2012. Please complete your budget plan and narrative on the enclosed forms and fax or email to Sandy Barnett, Public Service Administrator. The Kansas Advisory Group will meet to consider the grant requests, with award notifications being issued shortly thereafter. JJA intends to distribute funds on or about August 1, 2012. Please note that these funds are to be used during SFY 2013, commencing on July 1, 2012 and ending on June 30, 2013.
