

RESOLUTION NO. 172-2011

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE APPLICABILITY OF THE KANSAS PERSONAL AND FAMILY PROTECTION ACT TO COUNTY-OWNED AND COUNTY-LEASED REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Kansas Bill of Rights provides, in part, that a person has the right to keep and bear arms for the defense of self, family, home and state, and the United States Supreme Court has upheld the individual right to keep and bear arms; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas has enacted the Personal and Family Protection Act (K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 75-7c01, *et seq.*, hereinafter referred to as "the Act"); and,

WHEREAS, the Act restricts carrying concealed handguns on certain premises which are conspicuously posted in accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the Kansas Attorney General; and,

WHEREAS, the Act permits persons licensed thereunder to carry a concealed handgun within a building or buildings of counties whenever such building or buildings are not posted with appropriate notice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS that:

SECTION 1. Buildings identified in "Exhibit A" (which is attached and incorporated herein by reference) shall be conspicuously posted with signs as provided in K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 75-7c10(f), and persons licensed under the Act shall be prohibited from carrying a concealed handgun into any of such buildings.

SECTION 2. Except for the buildings identified in Section 1 hereof, every County-owned or County-leased building existing or acquired after the adoption of this resolution shall not be posted with signs as provided K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 75-7c10(f); and persons licensed under the Act shall be permitted to carry a concealed handgun into any of such buildings unless such signs are posted (a) on the exterior of a county-leased building, or (b) on the exterior of a county-owned building that is leased in whole to a lessee that chooses to post such signs, to the extent the carrying of concealed handguns is not otherwise restricted by any other federal or state law.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval and passage by the governing body of Sedgwick County, Kansas.

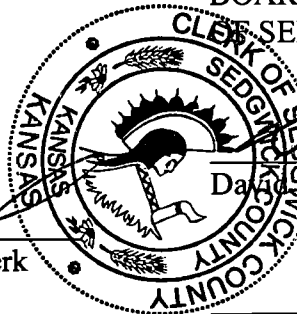
