

YHSI 5 year facility plan for Lake Afton Range

The Lake Afton public shooting range, operated by Young Hunters' Safety Inc. operates in an area approximately 400 feet by 400 feet located on the North side of Lake Afton Park. This area contains a 100 yard rifle and pistol shooting range enclosed on three sides by an earthen berm approximately 15 feet high. Also included inside this area is a 25 yard berm 8 feet high and approximately 40 feet long for shorter distance range use. In this area is also a garage storage building, office, restroom building, well house that provides water to the restrooms and covered firing line (160 feet long by 16 feet wide) that covers the area used for 100 yard shooting.

This facility is open to the public for recreational and competitive shooting events on a regularly scheduled basis provided YHSI has an adequate number of staff available to safely supervise such events. These dates are coordinated with the Park Superintendent and the designated Sheriff's office representative as per contract with the County. The range area will also be available for use by different community groups such as Big Brothers and Big Sisters, Scouts, Church groups, JROTC, Sedgwick County Sheriff Law Day, as well as Hunter Education classes and any others who present an appropriate need for use to the YHSI board of Directors. It is our intention to make the range available to as many who need access to a safe shooting facility for their specific shooting event as possible. We make this range available with the hope of enhancing quality of outdoor life activities for the surrounding community of South Central Kansas.

The range will be available to Sedgwick County Sheriff's office for firearms training. The dates for training will be set by the YHSI board of Directors approval following the Sheriff's office request for use so that the dates available will not interfere with any other scheduled events. When the Sheriff's office use of the range is occurring it will be the Sheriff's office responsibility to control the safety of the range.

We intend to maintain the buildings in no less of the condition they are currently in. During the last several years we have reroofed and painted the buildings. We also added earth to the 25 yard berm to raise the height and thickness of this berm. If our treasury funds are substantial enough we would like to extend the cover over the firing line over to the 25 yard berm. As in the past we will comply with the wishes of the Park Superintendent on any grounds keeping needs and consult with him on any changes we would like to make to the grounds or building.
