A RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO THE CITY OF WICHITA'S ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MAIZE 54 REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City of Wichita, Kansas, acting pursuant to the authority of K.S.A. 12-1770, *et seq.*, held a public hearing on November 20, 2012, to consider the establishment of the Maize 54 Redevelopment District; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 12-1771(d) provides that no privately owned property subject to ad valorem taxes shall be acquired and redeveloped under the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1770, *et seq.*, if the board of county commissioners levying taxes on such property determines by resolution adopted within 30 days following the conclusion of the hearing for the establishment of the redevelopment district that the proposed redevelopment district will have an adverse effect on the county; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Sedgwick County Commissioners, after due consideration of the proposed redevelopment district, determines that the Maize 54 Redevelopment District, as proposed by the City of Wichita, does not have an adverse effect on Sedgwick County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

SECTION I. The Maize 54 Redevelopment District as proposed by the City of Wichita does not have an adverse effect on Sedgwick County and the Board of County Commissioners hereby consents to its establishment.
