On the recommendation of Kim Evans, on behalf of Public Works, Jennifer Dombaugh moved to **accept the low bid from Cornejo & Sons, LLC in the amount of \$3,093,395.00.** Linda Kizzire seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Nova Chip Overlays are one of the tools used by Public Works to prolong the life of a road by adding a 1/2" overlay. This preventive maintenance program involves 47.75 lane miles of selected roads for 2014.

David Spears added for the record that there was a cost savings on this project compared to last year. In 2013, the county spent \$32,800.00 per lane mile, this year the cost is \$32,400.00 per lane mile.
