Notice to Interested Parties: The Sedgwick County Board of Sedgwick County Commissioners (the Board), on June 27, 2012, held a public hearing pursuant to K.S.A. 12-531. On that date the Board made a finding that the City of Valley Center has not provided services in accordance with the service plan prepared for the annexation that became effective on publication of Valley Center Ordinance No. 1145-07.


A copy of this finding shall be sent to the city and landowners in the area shown in Exhibit A.

If the services are not provided in accordance with the service plans as required by K.S.A. 12-532 within two and one half (2 1/2) years of the date of the Board's finding, the properties may be de-annexed as provided for by K.S.A. 12-532. If, after the two and one half (2 1/2) year period the city has not provided the services, any owner of land annexed may petition the Board to exclude their land from the boundaries of the city. Following receipt of the petition the Board will set the matter for public hearing and proceed according to K.S.A. 12-532.


