AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH SUBSTANCE ABUSE CENTER OF KANSAS

Sedgwick County, Kansas, ("County" and "	COMCARE") and	Substance Abuse Center of Kansas
("SACK" and "Contractor").		

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have entered into a contract on the 21ST day of January 2015, to provide a center and system of integrated services that supports and stabilizes individuals experiencing a substance use disorder crisis, actively engaged in them in treatment and recovery services in the community.

WHEREAS, the parties have found it necessary to make certain amendments to the original agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, conditions and promises contained herein, the parties hereto do agree the contract shall be changed as follows:

- 1. <u>Term:</u> The term of this contract shall be for twelve (12) months, commencing January 1st, 2015, and shall expire December 31st, 2015. This contract may continue for a reasonable time after December 31st, 2015, if both parties agree to continue operating under the terms of this contract while they are actively developing a contract for fiscal year 2016.
- 2. Compensation: County agrees to pay monthly payments with the exception of the initial quarter of the agreement. Upon execution of the grant agreement, COMCARE shall issue the first payment in an amount equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the total award, \$122,731.50. Beginning with the February 2015 period, line-item invoices based on the budget approved with the grant proposal will be submitted by the Contractor. The monthly invoices shall reflect actual expenditures for grant related activities, less any credit carried over from the initial payment. Total payment to the SACK shall not exceed \$478,926

All other conditions, covenants and promises contained in the original contract executed by the parties on January 21st, 2015, shall remain in full force and effect as written therein.
