On the recommendation of Kara Kingsley, on behalf of various county departments, Jennifer Dombaugh moved to accept the proposals from Ed Roehr Safety Products (Ed Roehr) lines 303, 304 and 317, and Galls LLC (Galls) for all remaining items and establish contract pricing for one (1) year with two (2) one (1) year options to renew. Sara Jantz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

A committee comprised of Lawrence Tangney, Carl Cox-SCFD; Paul Gibson, Brandon Ellis-EMS; Richard Powell, David Mattingly, Lin Dehning-Sheriff's Office; Ronald Spurgeon, Darrell Haynes-Courthouse Police; Cammie Campbell, Elaine Stull-Department of Corrections and Kara Kingsley - Purchasing, evaluated all responses on the overall quality of the vendor's proposal, proposed uniforms, web-based ordering system, professional reputation for product, customer service, timeliness, qualified staff and methodology to accomplish tasks. Galls and Baysinger Police Supply (Baysing er) presented demonstrations of their web-based ordering systems and overall proposal submitted. The committee unanimously agreed to recommend Galls, along with Ed Roehr for award.

Galls submitted a comprehensive, detailed and thorough response to Sedgwick County's solicitation and questions that included sample reports and example screenshots of their website ordering system. Galls offers a robust website that will allow each member of a participating de partment to order approved uniforms with a unique username and password. The website is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and is compatible with mobile dev ices. This allows an employee who works a varied schedule to order uniforms at their convenience. The website also offers administrative access to adjust information, add or delete users, as well as add or remove approved uniform or accessories. The website is capable of generating multiple reports that were demons trated during the presentation. The website is capable of displaying orders for both the employee and administrative users to view as well as real time tracking information. The website also allows administrative users to access copies of invoices, credit memos and pull reports. All employees with a department appr oved allotment will be able to track and spend down that amount with approved uniforms and accessories. If an employee goes over that approved allotment the website offers the ability to allow the employee to put the amount difference on their personal debit or credit card.

As requested in the RFP, Galls submitted competitive pricing. All costs associated with each item will include shipping, hand ling, embroidery, patches, screenprinting and any other applicable fees. Galls also responded in detail, the exact items they were pricing and included additional information if there were price changes for extended sizes. The pricing submitted is lower than what Sedgwick County is currently paying. Galls did submit a "no bid" for several items on the specification list; each department will work with either Galls to find a suitable substitute or will continue using their cu rrent vendor to purchase those specific items.

Galls will have a physical location, service center, up and running in 90-120 days. This service center will be a hub for public service employees to place orders, pick up orders, have items altered, receive a fitting and view on hand inventory of contracted items. Galls will also have a kiosk available for employees to

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browse the entire catalog as well as place orders. Galls will work with Sedgwick County to set hours for the service center that will include a weekend day. This allows extra flexibility for 24 hour staff to pick up orders or stop by the service center for any reason at their convenienc e
In the last year, both EMS and the Sheriff's Office have purchased uniforms and accessories through Galls and have received e xcellent customer service. The departments have experienced faster delivery times and accurate billing, and Galls has been able to provide items when other vendors were unable to, or unwilling to provide.

Baysingers submitted a response that lacked comprehensive detail. The response submitted simply had the line item number with a price next to it, no additional information was provided. The committee asked the vendor to supply us with more detail and they responded with mostly "bid as specified". As the process continued the committee found that there would be additional charges for shipping, handling, patches and over-sized garments. The committee was given no indication on their response (or follow up email) that there would be an additional shipping charge. Only during the best -and-final offer did the additional charge for shipping appear at $\$ 6.00$ per order.

However, during a second demonstration, the committee was told that the $\$ 6.00$ charge was for only commercial locations and not a private address. Sedgwick County will be charged $\$ 7.50-\$ 9.00$ to ship to a private address. All addresses and shipping requirements were stated in the RFP, under background information. During the second demonstration it was brought to the committee's attention that patches were not included in the pricing, that pricing included only sewing on the patch that was never clearly stated in their response or any additional communication. At this time, the committee is uns ure what the costs will be for each garment that includes a patch application. The best-and-final opportunity asked for pricing on extended sizes, the response submitted by Baysinger originally made no mention of additional charges. Baysinger responded to the best-and-final e-mail with an additional $10 \%$ for garments 2XL and above, pant size 46 and above and garments sizes outside the standard. After the second demonstration, the committee requested additional information on garments that were sized by neck and sleeve length as well as pant length, as these were not mentioned in the original response or the best-and-final response. The committee was told the additional $10 \%$ would include neck size beginning at 18.5 inches and sleeve length in excess of 37 inches. There is no additio nal charge up to 36.5 inches. However, anything longer than that will be considered custom order and will be quoted a special price. All of these charges are in addition to the pricing above. Galls provided detailed, firm pricing that is easy to understand, budget and audit.

The website demonstrated by Baysinger was not able to meet all the requirements that were listed on the RFP. Sedgwick County requested that the website allow administrative users to add/remove items on the website. The website that was presented by Baysinger doesn't have that capability. Communication would have to be made to Baysingers and they would have to add/remove items from the website. The RFP also requested that there be a way to track orders, including when delivery was made. Baysingers was not able to show this in either demonstration, but stated that was something that could be added and that it takes 10-14 days to implement. Galls was able to demonstrate their tracking ability in real-time and their website has the ability to allow its administrative users to add/remove items at their discretion.

EMS has been using some variation of the Baysingers' website for the past eight years. Within the last few weeks the EMS site has been updated to match what was demonstrated by Baysingers and staff is currently finding some discrepancies with the newest version compared to what Bay singers' response stated. EMS has found that invoices linked to their account have no name on them and items that are not approved by EMS. EMS suspects these invoices are not EMS orders. In Baysingers response to the RFP and during the demonstration it was stated that order history was kept indefinitely. EMS has never found that to be the case with any versions of their website, nor the current version. Currently, staff can view partial allowance purchases for 2014 a nd only allowance purchases made in 2015. EMS staff has never been able to view any new hired employees uniform purchases, only purchases made with uniform allow ances. Another discrepancy staff has found, and this has been an ongoing issue, is when an employee places an order over their allotment the website sho uld allow the employee to use a personal debit/credit card for the difference. Staff has experienced, with the older version, and has found with the newest version, that the system does not auto populate the amounts. In 2015, Sedgwick County had four instances where the entire order placed using the employee's personal debit/credit card instead of dividing it between the remaining allotment and the difference on their personal debit/credit card. When attempting to test, whether the newest version had solved that issue, staff found that it did not. Staff had to go in to adjust amounts manually right before ordering.

Sedgwick County's biggest concern is the level of customer service provided by Baysinger throughout the years. Each department has experienced delayed deliveries (some as long as over a year to get an item delivered), insufficient communication, inaccurate invoicing and a lac k of product availability. Baysingers' response to the RFP claimed to have a $99 \%$ accuracy rate, but Sedgwick County has found countless errors on embroidery (patches sewn upside down), orders (wrong items being delivered), invoicing (double billed, and billed for items never received), etc. Both EMS and Sherriff's O ffice have moved some or all of their purchases away from Baysinger in the last year to other vendors, including Galls, because of the lack of service.

Ed Roehr will supply body armor used by the Sheriff's Office only. Ed Roehr currently holds the State of Kansas contract (399 88) for item 304; this item will receive free shipping in compliance with that contract. Body armor was purchased by the Sheriff's Office in 2015 and their se rvice was excellent and the entire order was delivered in 30 days.

Total estimated yearly spend will be $\$ 276,000.00$. SCFD and EMS both have uniform spending policies that allow each employee an allotment to spend within a calendar year. Sheriff's Office currently does not have a uniform spending policy, but will be drafting one in coordination w ith this new contract. All other departments do not have an employee spending policy and purchase as needed through centralized administrative ordering.

Question - What was our spend last year? I don't have that exact amount, but it is approximate, I estimated .
Question - Could you talk about the complaints or concerns that there may have been under the current contract/current vendor? If you have complaints or concerns, maybe you could quantify and let us know how many. I just would like to have an understanding list of complaints/concerns that ordering departments may have had with the current vendor.

Paul Gibson with EMS: We have probably been the longest user of Baysingers online ordering system. It was incorporated in 2008, and we've been using it since then. We get numerous complaints, most complaints are verbal. I got an email just yesterday from an employee who orde red a pair of pants, got the incorrect pair, took them back to Baysingers to have them rectify it and alter the pants for him. Pants were taken to the st ore January $22^{\text {nd }}$ he heard nothing from Baysinger. Employee returned to the store this week, and Baysinger has lost the pants. They have no proof the pants were turned in, they have no proof the pants have been purchased, they have no indication where the pants are. Now this employee is out of a pair of pants, EMS has been invoiced for the pants, and the invoice paid. This is just one example that I get weekly. I have been documenting all experiences with Baysinger until the middle of January. Even today, I am getting invoices for items that have not been received, I get duplicate invoices.

In 2014, I received an invoice four separate times, invoiced under different numbers to be paid. It's frustrating and very time consuming for me to sit and go through numerous invoices to ensure accuracy. It's not a beneficial process for staff or for our service. In 2012, I received 97 invoices that were sent directly to EMS that belonged to the Sheriff's Office, Animal Control, or an EMS service that is not in Kansas. In 2015, we transitioned away from Baysinger. June 2015 we had a new hire academy, during this process employees were sent to Baysinger to get sized for uniform. In November of that year, two employees had never received any their uniforms. Employees must be fitted with uniforms within 15 days. In October, we transitioned and started buying uniforms for new hires through Galls. I measured employees, place the orders on a Tuesday and received $75 \%$ of uniforms on a Friday, took the unifor ms to an alterations vendor to have patches sewn on and the following Tuesday, uniforms were delivered to all employees, I was on vacation two of those days. I work daily with Finance to rectify invoices; I have several invoices that I have to go back to Baysinger with to get credit, invoices that have been paid but not received product for those purchases. I have invoices that have no name, and have no idea if it belongs to EMS or another service. This is just a small part of what we've experienced.

Colonel Powell with Sheriff's Office: We have experienced invoice accuracy issues for a significantly long time, at one point we had close to 100 open invoices, all had some type of inaccuracies in them. We had to bring a representative from Baysinger into our office to sit down and go through each invoice, line by line bv line. It took over half of the dav for mvself and staff members' time and someone from Bavsinger to explain evervthing. We've experienced significant delavs

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in delivery of product. We've had issues with partial delays, our office is 'uniform dependent' everyone wears a uniform that deals on a day-to-day basis direct with the public. Staff cannot have a pair of pants without a shirt to match it or vice versa. We've had issues with new re cruit classes that start new employees that have no uniform stock, and in the academy depending on whether its detention ( 11 weeks) or commissioned deputies ( 24 weeks), we have people, especially in the 11 week academy complete the academy and still have uniform attire. This is completely unacceptable.

In the recent past (last half of 2015), we have been placing orders with other vendors to test their capabilities and their p roduct. In the process of doing so, employees were notified about subscribing, purchasing and testing uniform products from other vendors and if they elect purch ase from Baysinger that would be of your own account. Our expectation is that employees will pay for any purchases from Baysinger. Baysinger has repeatedly sent invoices for purchases that should have been sent to the employees. Those invoices are returned unpaid, telling Baysinger that those invoices should be sent to the employees. We've had significant issues with double billing, receiving the same bill repeatedly after being paid. There were also instances where we never received a bill, but received a past due notice with a finance charge for product I don't have. That is a big concern for us. In the last year or so while out testing the capabilities of other products and support mechanisms, we've noticed that with the bids submitted now by Baysinger, we are paying significantly more right now (not small percentages, large dollar amounts) for products than what was bid on the contract. It may be because volume and the contract being in place. Not only a higher price but a significant price than what was paid in the past for the same product when we didn't have a contract. We have not had an active uniform purchasing contract for many years, we simply bought 'over the counter' with the vendor of choice at that time and gravitated to Baysing er as they have a local presence but also they were the only vendor in town at the time to provide the product and support services post sale and pre-sale on a regular basis.

Product sizing, as mentioned by Purchasing about the different variations, we've had issues sizing itself and getting the pro per size, but also having a clear understanding of what above, posted pricing was for what size, it was "consistently inconsistent". We never knew from one day to the next what specials up charge would entail for a particular product nor what the size limitations were.

Carl Cox with SCFD: Currently, the vendor we purchase from did not submit an RFP. However, I would echo what the comments of EMS and the Sheriff, uniform timeliness is very important to us. History from the other departments has shown Baysinger is unable to meet that consistently. Invoicing is very important to us, Fire District is a separate tax entity and having invoices cross over to the Sheriff, Fire and EMS can be very problematic, we support the Galls bid.

Question - Items 95 through 104 these are boots and shoes, I don't see who you're getting that from? Those are EMS boots they buy those from Redwing Shoes, they are the only supplier for those items.
