

## RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL SPEED ZONE ON 143<sup>RD</sup> STREET EAST FROM 700 FEET NORTH OF PAWNEE TO A POINT 2900 FEET NORTH OF PAWNEE (839-R), AND PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2001 et. seq., has the power and authority with respect to streets and highways under their jurisdiction and within the reasonable exercise of the police power to enact and enforce resolutions regulating traffic, said resolutions relating to those subjects enumerated K.S.A. 8-2002; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1560, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, is authorized to determine on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any maximum speed permitted is greater or less than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon a highway or part of a highway and to determine and declare a reasonable and safe maximum limit thereon, subject to the provision therein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1560, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, determines, on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation performed by the County Engineer of Sedgwick County, Kansas, that the maximum speed permitted is greater or less than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon 143<sup>rd</sup> Street East from 700 feet north of Pawnee to a 2900 feet north of Pawnee due to the proximity of Christa McAuliffe Academy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

SECTION ONE: A school zone speed limit is hereby established at 40 miles per hour on 143<sup>rd</sup> Street East from 700 feet north of Pawnee to a point 2900 feet north of Pawnee.

SECTION TWO: The school zone speed limit shall be effective only on days school is in session, and shall only be effective during the times during which students are en route to and from school on school days. Said times to be determined in cooperation with USD 259 based on start and end times for the school day.

SECTION THREE: The County Engineer is hereby directed to erect upon 143<sup>rd</sup> Street East, traffic control devices as may be most appropriate, giving notice of the school zone speed limit, denoted in miles per hour, and hours of effectiveness established by this resolution; and that said traffic control devices be in conformity with the most recent edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

SECTION FOUR: All law enforcement officers with jurisdiction in Sedgwick County, Kansas, are hereby authorized to enforce the school zone speed limit as described in Section One and Section Two above.

SECTION FIVE: Any person who shall violate any speed restriction established in this resolution shall be guilty of a misdemeanor as provided by law.


