

PREHEARING QUESTIONNAIRE – CITY

- 1) The service plan prepared by the city at the time of annexation described the following planned extension of services in the timetable:

Upon and after annexation

Street maintenance
Ditch cleaning
Culvert cleaning
Fire protection
Police protection
Parks
Library
City building code enforcement
City health code enforcement
Minimum housing code & zoning enforcement
Trash service (homeowner pays city-wide contractor)
Street name changes and signage

Upon petition or request of landowner(s)

Local street improvements
Water laterals
Fire hydrants
Sewer laterals
Street lights (as part of the city's 5-year capital improvement plan)

- 2) In addition, the text of the plan included the following statements of services to be provided:

Dry Creek crosses under 60th Street South via two – 7 x 5 ft. reinforced concrete box culverts (RCBC). These RCBC's appear to be in good condition; however, the guardrails on both upstream and downstream ends may not meet current safety standards and should be considered for replacement during the City's five-year planning for capital improvements.
