Purpose:	<p>The purpose of the funding is to enhance and/or develop behavioral health programs/interventions in the community and reduce revocations as a result.</p> <p>The FY2017 budget includes funding to sustain current positions that provide cognitive skills programming, peer mentoring and mental health strategies proven to reduce recidivism. Community Corrections agencies who received SFY14 - SFY16 awards were encouraged to submit a proposal with the intent of sustaining or enhancing strategies that have been implemented</p>
Eligibility:	Administrative Counties
Utilization:	Grant funds are used to cover all personnel, contractual and commodity expenses for the Behavioral Health program providers at Adult Intensive Supervision Program. Grant funds cover personnel expenses for four COMCARE positions. Corrections has a contract with Higher Ground to provide the Peer Mentoring program; which covers personnel costs.
