**A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-531 TO FIND AND DETERMINE THAT THE CITY OF DERBY (the City) HAS PROVIDED SERVICES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SERVICE EXTENSION PLAN - ANNEXATION ORDINANCE NO. 2157**

**WHEREAS**, K.S.A. 12-531 sets forth a procedure where Board of County Commissioners (the Board) must hold a hearing three years after the effective date of any annexation for which a city was required to provide a service extension plan; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 1, 2016, the Board held the hearing and the Board has considered evidence submitted during the hearing;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, THAT THE CITY BE NOTIFIED OF THIS FINDING:**

- Section I.** The Board has considered the evidence presented.
- Section II.** The Board hereby finds that the notice required by statute was provided, and further determines that the City has provided services in accordance with the service extension plan in the annexation which became effective upon publication of Annexation Ordinance No. 2157.
- Section III.** This resolution will take effect upon its passage. The County Counselor's office is also directed to send a copy of this resolution to the City.

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
