RESOLUTION RECLASSIFYING CERTAIN ROADS FROM THE GRANT TOWNSHIP ROAD SYSTEM TO THE SEDGWICK COUNTY HIGHWAY SYSTEM. SPECIFICALLY, 93RD STREET NORTH BETWEEN MERIDIAN AND SENECA (596-25).

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, has received a recommendation from the County Engineer that 93rd Street North between Meridian and Seneca (596-25) should be reclassified as a county road pursuant to K.S.A. 68-506, and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has determined that this section of road will receive increased traffic volumes due to construction improvements thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

1. 93rd Street North between Meridian and Seneca (596-25) be and is hereby reclassified from the Grant Township road system to the Sedgwick County highway system.
2. The County Engineer is hereby directed to notify Grant Township, Payne Township, Gypsum Township and Salem Township and to make proper entries recording these reclassifications.


