

## **ORDER DENYING PROPERTY TAX RELIEF**

NOW, on this 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2016, the same being a day for a special session of the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas ("Board"), there comes on for consideration an application for property tax relief by Michael Knight, 1337 E. 81<sup>st</sup> St. S., Haysville, KS, 67060 submitted on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2016, pursuant to K.S.A.79-1613, and Sedgwick County Resolution No. 103-2014.

THEREUPON, the Board, after examining the application and supporting documents as provided by the Sedgwick County Clerk's Office makes the following findings:

1. That the applicant's property at 1337 E. 81<sup>st</sup> St. S., Haysville, KS, 67060, was a homestead and occupied by applicant when it was 3% destroyed by flood on September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
2. That the assessed valuation of the homestead of applicant was \$16,020.00 and the 2016 property taxes on the property for all taxing authorities are \$1,923.72.
3. That neither the budgetary restraints of Sedgwick County nor the other affected tax districts preclude granting the requested property tax relief.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned, being the chairman of the Board, under the authority granted by Resolution No. 103-2014 and K.S.A. 79-1613 hereby denies a credit for the 2016 property taxes levied against the above homestead in the amount of \$1,923.72.
