

ORDER GRANTING PROPERTY TAX RELIEF

NOW, on this 15th day of March, 2017 the same being a day for a regular session of the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas ("Board"), there comes on for consideration an application for property tax relief by Lee and Geralyn Elder, 608 Brentwood Place, Andover, KS, 67002 submitted on the 3rd day of February, 2017, pursuant to K.S.A. 79-1613, and Sedgwick County Resolution No. 103-2014.

THEREUPON, the Board, after examining the application and supporting documents as provided by the Sedgwick County Clerk's Office makes the following findings:

1. That the applicant's property at 13217 E. Crestwood St., Wichita, KS, 67230 was a homestead and occupied by applicant when it was 85% destroyed by fire on October 18th, 2016.
2. That the assessed valuation of the homestead of applicant was \$36,755.00 and the 2015 property taxes on the property for all taxing authorities are \$4,483.53 less a \$46.00 reduction for a total amount of \$4,437.53.
3. That neither the budgetary restraints of Sedgwick County nor the other affected tax districts preclude granting the requested property tax relief.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned, being the chairman of the Board, under the authority granted by Resolution No. 103-2014 and K.S.A. 79-1613 hereby grants a credit for the 2016 property taxes levied against the above homestead in the amount of \$4,483.53 less a \$46.00 reduction for a total amount of 4,437.53.
