## **EQUIPMENT NARRATIVE (NON-FEDERAL)**

The 7500 Real Time System doubles the laboratory throughput for DNA quantification and enables male DNA detection methods for screening of sexual assault evidence. The Veriti thermal cycler would replace older models currently used in the lab which have been discontinued and the temperature verification kit is required for routine calibration verifications of the Veriti units, as required by national quality assurance standards. Heat block units will replace those that are 20+ years old and allow improved laboratory workspace configuration. The under counter freezers (specified for either pre- or post-amplification reagent storage) and refrigerator will replace aging household grade units. Updated computer systems will replace 32 bit workstations and accommodate more recent versions of analytical and statistical software.
