

RESOLUTION NO. 12 - 2014

A RESOLUTION AMENDING EXHIBIT A OF SEDGWICK COUNTY
RESOLUTION NO. 189-2013 PROVIDING FOR THE APPLICABILITY OF THE
KANSAS PERSONAL AND FAMILY PROTECTION ACT TO COUNTY-
OWNED AND COUNTY-LEASED REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Kansas Bill of Rights provides, in part, that a person has the right to keep and bear arms for the defense of self, family, home and state, and the United States Supreme Court has upheld the individual right to keep and bear arms; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas has enacted the Personal and Family Protection Act (K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 75-7c01, *et seq.*, hereinafter referred to as "the Act"); and,

WHEREAS, the Act restricts carrying concealed handguns on certain premises which are conspicuously posted in accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the Kansas Attorney General; and,

WHEREAS, the Act permits persons licensed thereunder to carry a concealed handgun within a building or buildings of counties whenever such building or buildings are not posted with appropriate notice; and

WHEREAS, the Sedgwick County Board of County Commissioners (the Board) previously adopted Resolution No. 189-2013, regarding applicability of the Kansas Personal and Family Protection Act to County-owned and County-leased real property; and

WHEREAS, changes regarding certain buildings listed in Exhibit A of that resolution require amendment of the Exhibit to reflect the revised status of concealed carry in those buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend Exhibit A of Resolution No. 189-2013;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS that:

SECTION 1. Exhibit A of Resolution No. 189-2013 is amended as shown on the attached Exhibit A. The remainder of Resolution No. 189-2013 remains in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval and passage by the governing body of Sedgwick County, Kansas.

ANY COUNTY FACILITY THAT IS NOT LISTED BELOW, WILL HAVE NO PROHIBITIONS AGAINST CONCEAL CARRY.

Concealed carry is not permitted in these County facilities.

Adequate Security Measures meeting the requirements outlined statute number K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 79-7c20 are present in these buildings. Persons with authority to enter these building via restricted access entrances that are not subject to County personnel policy and that have a concealed carry permit, will be able to carry concealed in the building.
