A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE PROPERTY TAXATION POLICY OF THE
GOVERNING BOARD OF SEDGWICK COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 1 WITH RESPECT TO
FINANCING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR 2018

Whereas, K.S.A. 79-2925b, as amended, provides that a levy of property taxes to finance the 2018 budget of Sedgwick County Fire District 1 exceeding the amount levied to finance the 2017 budget of Sedgwick County Fire District 1, as adjusted to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for calendar year 2016, be authorized by a resolution adopted in advance of the adoption of a budget supported by such levy; and

Whereas, K.S.A. 79-2925b, as amended, also provides that current year revenue that is produced and attributable to the taxation of (1) new improvements, (2) increased personal property valuation other than increased valuation of oil and gas leaseholds and mobile homes, (3) property located within added jurisdictional territory, and (4) property which has changed in use shall not be considered when determining whether revenue produced from property tax has increased from the preceding year; and

Whereas, Sedgwick County Fire District 1 provides essential services to protect the citizens in the District; and

Whereas, the cost of providing these services continues to increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of Sedgwick County Fire District 1 that a levy of property taxes in support of the 2018 budget exceeding the amount levied in support of the 2017 budget, as adjusted pursuant to K.S.A. 79-2925b(a), as amended, is hereby approved.
