

# 2017-2018 Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) Women, Infant, & Children (WIC) Special Supplemental Nutrition Program Grant Award Overview

## Sedgwick County Division of Health

### 2017-18 KDHE WIC Special Supplemental Nutrition Program Grant Award Summary

**Purpose:** The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) is a short-term intervention program designed to influence lifetime nutrition and health behavior in a targeted high-risk population.

WIC provides:

- Nutrition Education
- Breastfeeding support and education
- A monthly nutritious food package
- Referrals to other medical and community services
- Immunization screening
- WIC serves pregnant women, new mothers, breastfeeding women, infants and children under the age of five
- WIC requires income levels to be less than or equal to 185% of the poverty level and at least one medical or nutrition risk has to be documented.

**Eligibility:** The following information is provided per Dave Thomason, KDHE Bureau of Family Health and KS WIC Director:

- The federal regulations do not require that WIC be provided by a government entity. The regulations stipulate that the local agency be a “*public or private non-profit health agency*” or a “*public or private non-profit human service agency*”.

**Utilization:** Typically, 89% of the WIC funds support staff salary and benefits, 10% covers contractual costs, and administrative fees paid to the County, and 1% funds commodities.

**Grant Period:** October 1, 2017 – September 30, 2018
