A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING BRIDGE WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS FOR SPECIFIC BRIDGES WITHIN SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS; AND RESCINDING ALL PREVIOUS DESIGNATIONS OF BRIDGE WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS FOR SAID COUNTY BRIDGES WITHIN SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Assistant County Manager of Public Works, Facilities Maintenance, Project Services and County Engineer did cause to be made an engineering study of specific bridges on the Sedgwick County highway system; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, upon the recommendations made in the above mentioned engineering study, has determined the necessity and desirability of establishing bridge weight restrictions as recommended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS; THAT:

1. There is hereby approved and adopted the Highway Map of Sedgwick County, Kansas, prepared and published by the Sedgwick County Public Works on January 11, 2018. Said map designates and numbers all roads under the jurisdiction of Sedgwick County. Said map is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and is incorporated herein by reference.
2. The above referenced engineering study is hereby found to be reasonable and necessary for the public safety and welfare, and the bridges and weight limits are as listed in "Exhibit B" which is attached.
3. The Assistant County Manager of Public Works, Facilities Maintenance, Project Services and County Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to post signs at or near said bridge locations in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Bridges (most recent edition).
4. It shall be unlawful for any person to move or carry any machinery, equipment, or motor vehicle upon or across said Sedgwick County maintained bridges when the weight of such machinery, equipment, or motor vehicle exceeds the posted limit authorized herein. Any person who shall violate such posted restrictions shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine or fines in accordance with K.S.A. 1986 Supp. 8-1901, as amended.
5. That Resolution No. 143-2017 and any other previous resolutions pertaining to bridge weight restrictions are hereby rescinded.


