**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING SIMONE WARD TO THE  
SEDGWICK COUNTY ANIMAL CARE ADVISORY BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, K.S.A. 19-101d and Sec. 5-52 of the *Sedgwick County Code* provides for the appointment of members to the Sedgwick County Animal Care Advisory Board and sets forth the terms of such appointments;

**WHEREAS**, said resolution provides that each County Commissioner shall appoint two (2) members to the Animal Care Advisory Board;

**WHEREAS**, the terms for such appointments will be for four (4) years. In the event the Commissioner appointing a member leaves office for any reason, said term shall expire, except that a member so appointed may continue to serve until a successor has been duly appointed; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of Commissioner James M. Howell that Simone Ward be appointed to the Sedgwick County Animal Care Advisory Board to fill the unexpired term of Verne Yoho, who resigned December 20, 2017. This term shall expire June 9, 2019.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:**

Simone Ward is hereby appointed to the Sedgwick County Animal Care Advisory Board to fill the unexpired term which shall expire on June 9, 2019.
