SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LEGISLATIVE LIASON SERVICES by and between SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS

and

WATKINS AND SCHNEIDER CONSULTING, LLC

This Second Amendment entered into this _____ day of September 2018, by and between Sedgwick County, Kansas ("County") and Watkins and Schneider, LLC a company authorized to do business in the State of Kansas ("Consultant").

WHEREAS, County and Consultant entered into an Agreement for Legislative Liaison Services on January 21, 2015 ("Original Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of County and Consultant to extend the Original Agreement and alter other terms in the Original Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, conditions and promises contained herein, the parties hereto do agree to amend the Original Agreement as follows:

- 1. Term. The term shall be for one (1) year, beginning January 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019. The County, may, at its option, extend the term by two (2) additional one-year terms upon written notice to the Consultant.
- 3. Compensation. County agrees to pay and Consultant agrees to accept as compensation for the services provided pursuant to this Agreement, payment in the amount of \$4,583.33 per month for a sum not to exceed \$55,000 per 12 month period.

All other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement are retained under this Second Amendment to the Original Agreement and shall remain in full force and effect and govern the actions and obligations of the parties hereto unless specifically accepted or otherwise noted above.
