HRSA Healthy Start (HS) Grant				
Purpose:	The purpose of this Healthy Start (HS) program is to: Improve health outcomes before, during, and after pregnancy, and reduce racial/ethnic differences in rates of infant death and adverse perinatal outcomes.			
Eligibility:	Any domestic public or private entity. Domestic faith based organizations, tribal organizations are eligible to apply.			
Utilization:	Funding will be used to cover expenses for: routine monthly operating expenses incurred (copier, internet, cell phone, messaging plan. WiFi cards, employee mileage reimbursement, office supplies) and staff salaries. Wichita State University- evaluation team, electronic health record system.			
Grant Period:	April 1, 2019-March 31, 2024 (5 year grant cycle)
