On the recommendation of Kristen McGovern, on behalf of the Sheriff's Office, Tim Kaufman moved to **accept the quote from Night Vision Devices, Inc. for a total amount of \$59,484.00.** Randy Bargdill seconded the motion. The motion passed 4 to 1 with Colonel Powell abstaining from voting, as his office will utilize the purchase.

Within the Wichita-Sedgwick County law enforcement framework, there is a joint SWAT Team that is staffed by a combination of Wichita Police Department (WPD) and Sedgwick County Sheriff's Office personnel. Due to some changes in personnel, allotment and reformatting of the jointly staffed primary SWAT Team, certain equipment upgrades were required. WPD set the equipment standards since they have a higher number of personnel on the team. To provide for seamless interoperability between all personnel, the Sheriff's Office was required to upgrade equipment to match that of the WPD.
