

**A RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING NICKI SOICE TO
THE SEDGWICK COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 65-3405(b) states that each county of the State shall establish a Solid Waste Management Committee whose members are to be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners;

WHEREAS, the Sedgwick County Solid Waste Management Committee was established pursuant to Sedgwick County Resolution No. 275-2003, and the terms of the membership were amended by Sedgwick County Resolution No. 31-2012;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 31-2012, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, shall appoint one (1) member to the position of Chairperson;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, previously appointed Nicki Soice to serve on the Sedgwick County Solid Waste Management Committee in the position of Chairperson whose term has now expired; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, to reappoint Nicki Soice to the Sedgwick County Solid Waste Management Committee to Position No. 10 as Chairperson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

Nicki Soice shall be reappointed to the Sedgwick County Solid Waste Management Committee, as Chairperson, for a term of two (2) years to expire on December 31, 2020.
