**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING ERIC BERGIN TO THE
SEDGWICK COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 65-3405(b) states that each county of the State shall establish a Solid Waste Management Committee whose members are to be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners;

WHEREAS, the Sedgwick County Solid Waste Management Committee was established pursuant to Sedgwick County Resolution No. 275-2003, and the terms of the membership were amended by Sedgwick County Resolution No. 31-2012;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 31-2012, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, shall appoint one (1) committee-member, as a representative of the private solid waste industry, to Position No. 8;

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists due to the departure of Ryan Gatewood, who was appointed to the private solid waste industry position; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, to appoint Eric Bergin to the Sedgwick County Solid Waste Management Committee in Position No. 8 for the unexpired term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

Eric Bergin shall be appointed to the Sedgwick County Solid Waste Management Committee in Position No. 8 for the unexpired term which expires on December 31, 2019.


