RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt the Resolution and direct the Fire Chief and the Records Manager to destroy the records.

Ms. Melissa Thompson, RM & Archives Analyst, Division of Information, Records Management Services, greeted the Commissioners and said, "Before you today is the records disposal for Sedgwick County Fire District No. 1.
