A [18-531](#) PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE 2019 FIRE DISTRICT 1 BUDGET.

Presented by: Mike Scholes, County Manager.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Open the public hearing, receive public comment, and close the public hearing.

Mr. Mike Scholes, County Manager, greeted the Commissioners and said, "Commissioners, this morning is the first public agenda on the 2019 Fire District 1 budget. It totals \$20,487,728. This budget will be supported with a property tax levy of \$17,220,037, which will require a mill levy of approximately 18.371 mills based on the estimated assessed valuation and subject to technical adjustments. I recommend you open the public hearing, receive comments and close the public hearing once it is over. Thank you."

Chairman Dennis said, "Thank you, Mr. Manager. As I said, I skipped the Public Agenda today so that we could bring it up now. At this time, I'd like to open the public hearing and receive public comment on the budget for the Fire District. Does anyone in the audience, I didn't have anyone sign up.
