### Affiliation Agreement with the Mental Health Association of South Central Kansas.

Recommended Action: Approve the agreement and authorize the Chairman to sign.

Background: This affiliation agreement allows the Mental Health Association of South Central Kansas (MHA) to receive payment from Medicaid for mental health services provided for adults and youth with a serious mental illness. Services are billed through COMCARE, as the community mental health center for Sedgwick County, and payment is made to MHA only after reimbursement funds are received from Medicaid. The Mental Health Association provides adult and child case management, adult peer support, parent support, case conference, wrap-around facilitation, psychosocial rehabilitation, and attendant care services for Sedgwick County residents who are experiencing mental illness. The services provided under this contract will follow all applicable standards as required by law, regulation, and accrediting agencies.

Alternatives: The services provided under this agreement help support adults and youth with a mental illness, and without them, individuals may have delayed and/or decreased access to the services needed to help them live successfully in the community.

Term: 01/01/17-12/31/17

Financial Considerations:

Cost: MHA provides approximately \$5.5 million in services throughout the contract year.

Funding Source: 310686-17 and 310646-17 Affiliate Billing/ Medicaid Pass Through

Budget Authority Adjustment: Sufficient budget authority is included in the 2017 budget; no additional authority is requested.

Legal Considerations: The authority for this action is K.S.A. 19-101. A simple majority vote is required.

Policy Considerations: All Sedgwick County policies have been followed in the development of this renewal agreement
