### Professional Service Agreement between Wichita State University and the Sedgwick County Department of Corrections.

Recommended Action: Approve the agreement and authorize the Chairman to sign.

Karen Countryman-Roswurm, Executive Director of Wichita State University's Center for Combating Human Trafficking, will provide four hours of training for Sedgwick County Corrections staff on how to work effectively with trauma-impacted youth in detention.
