### Agreement with Higher Ground to enhance Behavioral Health Services for Community Corrections clients.

Recommended Action: Approve the contract and authorize the Chairman to sign.

Sedgwick County Community Corrections was awarded an allocation of \$592,803.00 for the period beginning on July 1, 2016, and ending on June 30, 2017, for Behavioral Health Services. D.B.A. Higher Ground will receive a portion of this allocation to fund recovery specialists to assist with one-on-one mentoring, substance abuse evaluations and treatment and case management services to clients on intensive probation and in the residential setting.

Higher Ground, Peer Mentoring Program - \$99,800.

The Sedgwick County Community Corrections Advisory Board approved the Kansas Justice Reinvestment Initiative (JRI) proposal and allocation of funds on April 14, 2016. The BOCC approved this allocation on April 18, 2016.
