### Annual Affiliation Agreement with Dream Vision, LLC.

Recommended Action: Approve the Agreement and authorize the Chairman to sign.

This agreement is for a new affiliate and serves to subcontract the provision of Intellectual and Developmental Disability (I/DD) services in Sedgwick County to organizations and individuals that have met Kansas Department on Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) and Community Developmental Disability Organization (CDDO) standards. As the CDDO contracting with KDADS for Sedgwick County, this agreement assures that services are provided for eligible individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities.

The agreement for the following contractor provides both the ability to bill the Medicaid system directly and to receive payment from Sedgwick County for services that are provided to eligible individuals through August 31, 2017.

Dream Vision, LLC

Alternatives: The SCDDO is required to contract with qualified service providers that have been selected by an individual who is eligible to receive intellectual and developmental disability services. All listed providers have been selected as the preferred provider for at least one individual.

Financial Considerations: All listed providers may receive payments directly from Sedgwick County and/or bill Medicaid directly for services provided. Because the I/DD service system works on a reimbursement basis, funding will not be paid to providers until after the service has been provided and verified.
