CONTRACT FOR A HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE REMOTE COLLECTION EVENT ON JUNE 24, 2017 WITH USD 260 FOR DERBY NORTH MIDDLE SCHOOL.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve the contract.

Background: Sedgwick County has a Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)Facility at 801 Stillwell. Studies have shown that the majority of customers come from within a 6 mile radius. In order to provide safe household hazardous waste disposal to our community, the County offers 5 Remote Household Hazardous Waste collection events each year. These events allow residents to bring such items as paints, oils, cleaners, solvents, and other chemicals for proper disposal at a location near them. This agenda item addresses a contract for a remote household hazardous waste collection event at Derby North Middle School. USD 260 approved this contract on May 22, 2017. The collection will take place on June 24, 2017 from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm at Derby North Middle School Parking Lot, located at 3100 N Rock Rd, Derby, KS.

Alternatives: Do not provide this community service.

Financial Considerations: HHW has provided 5 remote HHW collection events every year since 2005. Funding for these events comes from the Solid Waste Fee and expenditure authority is included in HHW Services fund center (43001-208, Contractual Services) as part of the 2017 Adopted Budget. The cost of \$16,400 is based on the average cost of HHW remote events in 2016. The actual cost will vary based on the number of participants and types of materials received. There are no revenues associated with this event.
