### Agreement with the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) regarding the treatment of noxious weeds growing on KDOT right of way in Sedgwick County. All Districts.

Recommended Action: Approve the agreement and authorize the Chairman to sign.

Alternatives: N/A

Financial Considerations: Costs associated with the recommended agreement are budgeted in the County's 2018 Adopted Budget and will be reimbursed by the State of Kansas, per the agreement, into cost center 22001-207, Noxious Weeds. The agreement is a significant revenue source for the Noxious Weeds Department and accounts for around \$25,000 of non-tax revenue annually.

Legal Considerations: The BoCC is authorized to make all contracts in relation to the concerns of the County under K.S.A. 19-101 *fourth*. The Secretary of the Kansas Department of Transportation and the County Commission have a duty to control the spread of noxious weeds under K.S.A. 2-1314. This contract is similar in terms and conditions to prior contracts approved by the BoCC for this purpose. Approval is by simple majority vote.
