Jan Schultz, also known as "Grandma Jan," wrote and donated 2800 booklets with titles including:

A Dog Named Keeper Turnback Bethany and Anita Elmer Box Turtle The Cat With One Ear Janey's Notes Home Sweet Home Monti And His Extraordinary Train Ride Sam Knew the Way Home

Per input from the author, the books are written at about the third/fourth grade level. Each story has a happy ending and includes a simple life lesson. They are designed for the recipient to color in the pictures and to add details of their own. Youngsters will understand each story at a child's level, but there's always a more complicated message there for adult readers.
