Resolution authorizing the establishment and installation of traffic control devices at certain intersections of township roads within Illinois Township, and providing for the enforcement thereof. District 3.

Recommended Action: Adopt the Resolution.

Mark Borst, Traffic Engineer:

We reviewed the intersection, and counts were taken to determine the incoming split of traffic. Counts are typical for township roads, and 47th Street South has the lowest incoming count. Therefore, I suggested yield control as it is the least restrictive. The township has concurred, and a resolution has been prepared.

Legal Considerations: The BoCC is authorized to perform such duties as required by law concerning roads under K.S.A. 19-212 *Ninth*. Under K.S.A. 8-2001, et seq. the Board has the power and authority with respect to streets and highways under its jurisdiction and within the reasonable exercise of the police power to enact and enforce resolutions regulating traffic, said resolutions relating to those subjects enumerated in K.S.A. 8-2002.
